The Project consists of repairs to the Runway 22R Threshold by means of concrete pavement removal, asphalt paving, and electrical equipment removal and replacement.

Penn resolves Lia Thomas-related Title IX case

Field Level Media

The University of Pennsylvania and the U.S. Department of Education announced an agreement Tuesday that leads to swimmer Lia Thomas being stripped of her school records achieved during the 2021-22 season.

The fate of the NCAA title she won the 500-yard freestyle in 2022 is now in question.

The agreement resolves the investigation launched by the Department of Education in February regarding Penn's compliance with Title IX. The DOE determined in April that the Ivy League school had violated Title IX, which forbids sex discrimination in sports.

When Thomas competed for Penn's women's team -- becoming the first openly transgender athlete to claim a national title -- the school was in compliance with NCAA eligibility rules.

Thomas also set Penn President J. Larry Jameson released a statement that addressed several aspects of the DOE's concerns.

"Consistent with the Federal Government's current interpretation of Title IX and current NCAA policies, we have signed a resolution agreement with the Department of Education that includes the following actions:

"Releasing a public statement reaffirming our commitment to fully comply with Title IX in all of our athletic programs and

to continuously adapt our practices as Title IX evolves over time. This includes adhering to definitions of sex -- with respect to women's athletics -- that have been set out through two specific Executive Orders.

"While Penn's policies during the 2021-2022 swim season were in accordance with NCAA eligibility rules at the time, we acknowledge that some student-athletes were disadvantaged by these rules. We recognize this and will apologize to those who experienced a competitive disadvantage or experienced anxiety because of the policies in effect at the time.

"We will review and update the Penn women's swimming records set during that season to in-

Virginia swimmer Walsh top college woman athlete

Virginia star swimmer Gretchen Walsh won the prestigious Honda Cup as the top Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year.

The other finalists were UConn basketball star Paige Buckeers and Texas Tech softball player Nijaree Canady.

Walsh joins basketball legend Dawn Staley (1991) as the only Cavaliers to win the honor.

Walsh is the ninth swimmer to win the award, a list that includes

two-time winner Tracy Caulkins (1982, 1984), Missy Franklin (2015) and Katie Ledecy (2017).

"I feel like I'm on cloud nine right now," Walsh said after being named the winner. "Honestly, being nominated for this award last year was a big deal to me. To win it this year is obviously unreal. It's interesting this sport, you know, it's all-year-round, and it feels like it never stops. But to have these moments of knowing that all the hard work and the never-ending training is coming to fruition, and it's

worth it.

"It's really nice to have this recognition and to win this award among such an amazing group of athletes. And these women, all of us, different disciplines, different sports, but just excelling in all fields, it is really cool to be represented in a group like this."

Walsh won NCAA individual titles in the 50-meter freestyle, 100-meter freestyle and 100-meter butterfly this season to raise her total to nine titles. She also holds nine NCAA records (four in-

dividual, five relays).

The Cavaliers won four straight team titles during Walsh's career.

Of course, Walsh is also known for her international profile and she won three gold medals and one silver at last month's U.S. national championships. She set the world record with a time of 54.60 seconds in the 100 butterfly at the TYR Pro Swim Series.

At the 2024 Olympics in Paris, Walsh won two gold medals and two silvers.

Charlie McAvoy (Boston Bruins), Brady Tkachuk (Ottawa Senators) and Matthew Tkachuk (Florida Panthers).

"Best-on-best international tournaments like the Olympics provide the opportunity to create extraordinary moments for our players and fans alike," said Marty Walsh, executive director of the NHL Players' Association.

NHL players last took part in the Olympics in Sochi, Russia, in 2014. Four years later, the NHL and IOC couldn't agree on who would pay for travel and other agreements for

the 2018 Olympics in South Korea.

Issues relating to the pandemic kept NHL players out of the 2022 Olympics in Beijing.

It has been presumed NHL players would participate in the 2026 Games. On June 16, the 12 countries participating in men's hockey in Milano-Cortina 2026 named the first six preliminary players to their national rosters. Most of them are NHL players.

Kansas State football players share high praise for this transfer wide receiver

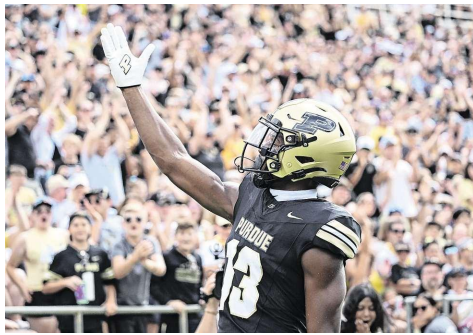

Taylor Poitier has been a member of Kansas State's offensive line since 2019, so it's worth noting when the seventh-year senior goes out of his way to praise a group of new teammates before they've even played their first games in a purple uniform.

"Our offense will be a little different this season," Poitier said Tuesday at Big 12 Media Days. "We have got a lot more guys to get the ball to, so that's really exciting."

Poitier is particularly eager to see how junior wide receiver Jaron Tibbs will complement a group of skill players that already featured Avery Johnson at quarterback, Dylan Edwards at running back, Jayce Brown on the

outside and a plethora of talent at tight end. Tibbs, a 6-foot-2 trans-

fer from Purdue, made a strong first impression on the Wildcats during spring

practices. "You can already tell," Poitier said, "that he's

going to be really good." Johnson also likes what he has seen from his new wide receiver.

The junior quarterback said K-State coaches placed a white board outside of the team's indoor practice facility in the spring and asked for players to write down the names of any player who impressed them. Nobody got more shoutouts than Tibbs.

"It wasn't just offensive players saying that either," Johnson said. "A lot of our defensive guys all talked about how good of a job he did."

Johnson is glad to have him in the K-State receiving corps.

"He is going to be a dude for us this year," Johnson said. "He's just a big, physical receiver. The dude is well put together. He's smart, a really good route-runner, strong hands, good at catching in traffic. He does a lot of things that you can't teach. We built a really good connection this offseason."

That will certainly come as good news to K-State football fans.

Wide receiver has typically been a weakness during the Chris Klieman era. Last season, only

Jayce Brown (47 catches for 823 yards and five touchdowns) was able to eclipse 360 yards through the air. Most of Johnson's touchdowns were thrown to running backs and tight ends.

It was also like that when the Wildcats utilized Deuce Vaughn and Ben Sinnott as their main receiver threats. Perhaps K-State will have more of a one-two punch at receiver with Brown and Tibbs on the perimeter.

Tibbs only grabbed 25 passes for 305 yards and two touchdowns as a sophomore at Purdue. But a change of scenery seems to be working out for both him and K-State as the Wildcats prepare for the 2025 season.

In February, Tibbs said he transferred to K-State because he wanted to be a deep threat for Johnson.

"There are a lot of explosive plays in this offense," Tibbs said. "And it's not just centered around passing or running the ball. It's a mix of both, because we have a good quarterback. Being a part of this was just something I felt like I couldn't pass up."

Former Missouri Tigers football coach Gary Pinkel arrested for alleged DWI

Former University of Missouri football coach Gary Pinkel was arrested Monday night in Camden County for allegedly driving while intoxicated.

According to a Missouri State Highway Patrol report, Pinkel, 73, was

arrested at 11:46 p.m. and held at Camden County Jail before being released.

While Pinkel will be charged with a DWI, according to the report, no charges had been filed as of Tuesday afternoon.

This could result in Pinkel's second DWI. On Nov. 16, 2011, Pinkel, then still Missouri's head coach, was charged with a DWI

just three days before the final home game of the season against Texas Tech. According to the Boone County Sheriff's Department, Pinkel was pulled over on Keene Street near Broadway and U.S. 63 after driving recklessly.

Amid a failure to recite the alphabet and count backwards from 73 to 62,

Pinkel told the arresting officer that he'd consumed two "jumbo" glasses of wine at a post-practice dinner.

Pinkel pleaded guilty, receiving a 30-day suspended jail sentence. He was also fined by Missouri and suspended for the Texas Tech game, which Missouri won 31-27.

Talking to reporters a few days after the start of his suspension, Pinkel showed remorse for his actions.

"I've taken full responsibility for my lack of judgment and poor decision," Pinkel said at the time. "I've hurt and disappointed a lot of peo-

ple. ... I've always tried to be a good and positive role model."

"Now it's up to me to begin earning everyone's trust and respect back," he added. "This will never, ever happen again."

Pinkel, a member of the College Football Hall of Fame and College Football Playoff Selection Committee, coached the

Tigers from 2001 to 2015. During his tenure, Missouri tallied five double-digit win seasons. The Tigers also recorded 10-plus wins in consecutive seasons twice during that time, 2007-08 and 2013-14. Such a feat had never been accomplished in Missouri history until 2008.

New York Knicks' summer league roster includes a healthy Kevin McCullar Jr.

New York Knicks second-year wing Kevin McCullar Jr., who was limited to just four games his rookie season as he rehabbed from a knee injury suffered his senior campaign at Kansas, will be part of the NBA team's 2025 Summer League roster, the Knicks have announced.

A second-round pick (No. 56 overall) in the 2024 NBA Draft, McCullar recently was tendered a qualifying offer by the Knicks, making him a restricted free agent. The Knicks have the right to match any offer he might receive from another team.

According to the New York Post, he is expected to be resigned to a two-way contract. McCullar's two-way deal reportedly paid him \$578,577 during the 2024-25 season. The 6-foot-6, 210-pound McCullar, 24, scored six points on 2-of-7 shooting in his four games with the Knicks a year ago. He had four points, eight rebounds and two assists against Brooklyn in his final appearance of the season on April 13.

Playing 13 games for the G League's Westchester Knicks, he averaged 11.6 points, 4.9 rebounds, 4.2 assists and 1.6 steals in 27.8 minutes per contest. He committed 2.1 turnovers a game. McCullar scored 21 points on 9-of-18 shooting (1-of-5 from 3) with seven rebounds, six assists and two steals in Westchester's playoff

loss vs. Maine.

"An older prospect at the age of 24 (he turns 25 on March 15), McCullar will need to prove he can knock down shots from the perimeter to excel in the league. The wing shot only 22.2 percent from 3 in 13 regular season G League games," wrote Rafael Canton of SNY TV.

"McCullar has a good feel for the game and can make an impact in multiple ways, as evidenced by him averaging 18.3 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.1 assists in his last collegiate season."

After scoring his first NBA points in a win over Dallas on March 25 at Madison Square Garden in New York, McCullar was handed the game ball by Josh Hart. Hart gave McCullar the memento despite the fact he had just set a record for most triple-doubles in a season in franchise history (nine).

"Getting your first NBA points, no one can take that away from you. It is important that he got the game ball for that," Hart said after the game.

"It felt amazing. It felt good. As a kid, that is what you dream of doing, so to go out there and finally get in the game and be able to score my first bucket was big," McCullar said after the game.

Noted former Knicks head coach Tom Thibodeau: "Kevin has worked extremely hard and he's been through a lot. He's gone step by step with his rehab, long, arduous and he's worked his way through that. He put together some really good games in the G League.

There's an appreciation for the way he's worked. He's a great kid. We're happy for him. The team is first for everybody. We're proud of him."

Of McCullar's development as an NBA player, Thibodeau said: "Steady improvement, he's learning, getting better every game. He's made a lot of good plays. His ability to read and everyone can play off of that. When everyone starts helping each other the game is a lot easier. That's important."

McCullar had back-to-back triple doubles in the G League in 2024-25. He had 20 points, 10 assists and 10 rebounds against the College Park Skyhawks, then followed that with 23 points, 10 assists and 10 rebounds also against the Skyhawks.

"McCullar was a savvy college player who did well moving without the ball and in the open floor. He had solid defensive moments in college despite his lack of athleticism," wrote James Edwards of the New York Times.

"McCullar, who played many roles in college, plays in a way that is better in a team concept than as an individual, which is

good. But unless the shooting translates ... it's hard to see how he carves out a role for himself. To show what he can do, though, McCullar has to prove he can stay healthy. The best way to work on your game and impress decision-makers is to be out there playing. With hopes of sticking with the Knicks for one more season, the 24-year-old needs to show that he can make it to the end of Las Vegas healthy and be around to show off his game this summer," Edwards added.

The Knicks, who will be coached by Jordan Brink of the team's video and analytics department, will open Las Vegas Summer League play against the Detroit Pistons at 5 p.m. Central on Friday. Other Knicks games in Vegas: vs. Boston, 4:30 p.m., Sunday; vs. Brooklyn, 5 p.m., Tuesday; and vs. Indiana at 3:30 p.m., July 17.

Other Jayhawks in summer league: Hunter Dickinson (New Orleans), Dajuan Harris (Charlotte), Johnny Furphy (Indiana) and Zeke Mayo (Washington).

Billionaire in ATP event a mockery of pro tennis

Despite its roots as a recreational pursuit of the elite, modern-day tennis is about as close to a meritocracy as you'll find in professional sports.

Whether it's Wimbledon or the lowest-ranked tournament in tennis' minor leagues, there aren't any shortcuts to getting in. You qualify based on accomplishment. You can only advance to the next level by winning. You eat what you kill. You get what you deserve. And you are what your ranking says you are.

Unless, of course, you're billionaire hedge fund guy Bill Ackman.

On the afternoon of July 9, the 59-year-old founder of Pershing Square Capital Management was scheduled to suit up at the Hall of Fame Open in Newport, Rhode Island, indulging his sports fantasy while making a mockery of the tournament and the ATP Challenger Tour where players strive to eke out a living.

"I am playing the best tennis of my life," Ackman wrote last week on X, where he posts frequently about politics and his often far-too-eager to embrace ridiculous conspiracy theories.

Including the idea that he belongs in a pro tennis event.

Ackman's enthusiasm for tennis is indisputable. He's a bit of a gaffly on tour, befriending several players and helping bankroll the Professional Tennis Players Association when it was launched in 2019 by Novak Djokovic and Vasek Pospisil. He says he practices nearly every day, seems to be in good shape for a 59-year-old and, because of his access to top players, has found himself on the other side of the net from all-time greats like Roger Federer in informal hitting sessions.

And still, there is no deeper story to what's happening in Newport this week other than exactly what it looks like: A wealthy tennis benefactor who started playing seriously a decade ago using his privilege to say he competed in a pro tour event. We can be honest about how gross that is — both in Ackman's desire to make it happen and the ATP's willingness to humor him.

How did it happen?
According to Ackman's social media posts, former Wimbledon finalist Nick Kyrgios had proposed playing doubles together at one point, but ongoing injury issues delayed their partnership indefinitely.

"Fortunately fate intervened," Ackman wrote. Of course, it's not fate. It's simply the privilege of being Bill Ackman. Let's explain.

Even though entrants for every tournament on the ATP or Challenger Tour level must meet a rankings threshold or earn a spot through a qualifying event, every tournament reserves a handful of wild cards that can be given out at its discretion.

The wild-card system isn't perfect and sometimes creates controversy, but in general they're used for reasonable purposes: Accomplished players who lost their ranking due to injury and are trying to come back,

an up-and-coming star with local ties, a highly ranked player who didn't enter initially but decided to play at the last minute.

The Newport event, which was downgraded from ATP-level to a Challenger tournament this year, gave the wild card in doubles to Jack Sock on the basis of being a former champion of the tournament and one of the most accomplished doubles players of the last decade.

There's just one little issue: Sock, 32, is a pickleball player and podcaster now. His last professional tennis match was at the US Open in 2023, and there is no indication that he's planning a comeback. Also interesting: In an interview with Front Office Sports last week, Ackman said he had never even met Sock but that they were going to begin practicing together last weekend. So Sock — out of the blue, apparently — requested a wild card from Newport even though his tennis career has long been over. The tournament granted it, and Sock listed Ackman as his doubles partner. Which, again, the tournament allowed even though you can't find results on Ackman in any of the public tennis databases kept by the USTA or Universal Tennis Rating (UTR).

Why was Ackman approved to compete? One truly wonders — unless, of course, you know how the world works.

But that's not how tennis is supposed to work. Look, it's not the end of the world. While technically the Ackman-Sock wild card would have gone to a legiti-

mate team that needed the opportunity rather than a sideshow, nobody's career is going to hinge on missing the cut for the doubles draw at the Newport Challenger.

But this isn't a golf pro-am. It's the real thing. And as long as we have pro sports, you'd like them to be played by professionals and not exist for the whims of potential benefactors who have a ton of money and a delusion about how good they are at playing tennis.

It's a bad look, and it certainly doesn't help the image of a sport that does not necessarily deserve its country club reputation.

While some top-ranked players came from privilege, it's not really that different from most other sports. The top two men's players, Jannik Sinner and Carlos Alcaraz, both emerged from middle-class backgrounds. Djokovic grew up flat-out poor in a war-torn country. Coco Gauff started on the public courts in Delray Beach, Florida, inspired by Serena and Venus Williams' rise from Compton, California, to the top of the sport. And even for those who had advantages like Jessica Pegula, whose parents own the Buffalo Bills, there's no faking it in tennis.

You have to win the right matches to establish your ranking, which gets you in the right tournaments, which only allows you to maintain that privilege if you keep winning.

You can't use your social media fame or friendships or wealth to buy your way onto the pro tour. Unless, apparently, you're Bill Ackman.
